### Practical Nursing Program – Admission Selection Points Worksheet

The Practical Nursing Program has limited enrollment and a selection process for admission into the Program. After all admission eligibility requirements for placement into the selection pool have been satisfied and applicant has applied online for the Practical Nursing Program, the Nursing Program uses the following point system for selection into the program. **(Please note: if the student chooses to take BIO 211, they must also successfully complete BIO 212.)** Top scorers receive conditional admission in ranking order based on seats available. We place all other eligible applicants on an alternate list in ranking order. If students have the same total point count, we will rank according to the date/time that the Nursing application was submitted.

## **INSTRUCTIONS/NOTES FOR EACH SECTION**

**A**

Points based on your valid qualifying ACT, SAT, or TEAS score. **Note: TEAS scores are valid for 2 years. SAT and ACT scores are valid for 5 years.**

**B**

Points based on previous college level course work and college degree.

The point value you select should be based on the highest grade you received in the specified course.

**C**

BIO 111, BIO 211, BIO 212, MDT 100 are Carl Sandburg College course numbers. See the Carl Sandburg College Course Catalog for course descriptions. ***\* All Science courses must not have been taken more than (7) years prior to the time of application.***

**D**

Points based on a previous C.N.A certification. Certification must be active on Healthcare Worker Registry with one year of clinical experience.

**E**

This is where you total up the points you have earned in sections A-E (Note the maximum allowed for each section).

**Minimum of 5 points required.**

- Student must have evidence of satisfactory academic progress in order to be eligible for financial aid consideration for the program (if a student is on suspension from Carl Sandburg, they are not eligible).
