

In accordance with applicable state and federal laws, rules, and regulations, including the Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act Amendments of 1989 and EDGAR Part 86, the unlawful use, possession, manufacture, and/or distribution of alcohol, marijuana, and/or any controlled substance while on College-owned or controlled property or at College-sponsored activities is prohibited. For the purposes of this policy, the term “controlled substance” shall refer to all illegal drugs and to legal drugs.

The College has a substance abuse awareness program to inform students and employees about:

- a. The dangers of substance abuse,
- b. The College policy of maintaining a substance abuse free environment,
- c. Any available substance abuse counseling and rehabilitation assistance programs,
- d. The penalties that may be imposed upon students and employees for substance abuse violations occurring in the College.

The consumption of alcoholic beverages and/or the possession of opened containers of alcoholic beverages is prohibited on college property.
