

The Board charges the college administration with the responsibility and the authority to establish and to implement rules and regulations that protect freedoms guaranteed by the First Amendment to the U.S. Constitution.

The orderly conduct of the college educational programs as well as the safety and welfare of persons on campus will be of primary importance. Freedom of speech, peaceable assembly, petition and association as well as all civil rights are accorded to all employees.

Where emergency situations occur, the administration shall be authorized to undertake reasonable and appropriate measures to correct and control potential dangers.
