

**College of Nursing & Health Professions
Practical Nursing Program – Admission Selection Points Worksheet**

The Practical Nursing Program has limited enrollment and a selection process for admission into the Program. After all admission eligibility requirements for placement into the selection pool have been satisfied and applicant has applied online for the Practical Nursing Program, the Nursing Program uses the following point system for selection into the program. The maximum number of points is 18 points for BIO 111 or maximum number of points is 22 for both BIO 211 **and** BIO 212. **(Please note: if the student chooses to take BIO 211, they must also successfully complete BIO 212.)** Top scorers receive conditional admission in ranking order based on seats available. We place all other applicants on an alternate list in ranking order.

- Student must have evidence of satisfactory academic progress in order to be eligible for consideration for the program.

- Rank all TEAS (AIS) scores at or above 60
 - Anyone with a TEAS (AIS) score below 60 will not be considered for admissions
