



All students must have one of the following to be admitted to the college:

- Take COMPASS or ACCUPLACER within past 5 years
- ACT scores of 20 reading, 19 English, 22 math within 5 years
- SAT scores of 480 for English and 530 for Math within 5 years
- PARCC score of 4 or 5 in ENG or MAT within 2 years
- An approved high school transition course in mathematics with a grade of C or higher.
- A GED score of 165 for reading/writing portion and a 165 on math score or comparable score on other high school equivalency tests within the last 5 years.
- A HiSET score of 15 for Mathematics, 15 for Language Arts – Reading, 15 for Language Arts – Writing, and a 4 for a Language Arts – Writing essay test within the last 5 years.
