

Carl Sandburg College Indoor Event Guidelines

Effective Jan. 11, 2022, Carl Sandburg College will institute a proof of COVID-19 vaccination (fully vaccinated as defined by the CDC) or negative test protocol for all indoor events on campus. This is in response to the recent surge in COVID-19 cases throughout our region. In compliance with the state's mandate, properly fitting face masks continue to be required and must be worn appropriately during all indoor events held on campus. The College continues to encourage physically distancing when possible and proper hand hygiene.

All guests ages 12 and older will be required to show proof of COVID-19 vaccination or a negative COVID-19 PCR or rapid test taken within 7 days of the event.

Upon entry to an indoor event, one of the following will be required:

- An official, government-issued vaccination card listing the guest's name and dates the last dose was administered
- A photo or digital version of an official government-issued vaccination card listing the guest's name and dates the last dose was administered
- Carl Sandburg College students/faculty/staff displaying a CLEARED4 access pass
- A printed or digital negative PCR or rapid test within 7 days of the event that includes the guest's name and date the last test was administered. Only FDA-approved home testing kits are accepted. Home kits must provide date the test was administered and name of the guest to whom the test was administered.
- If you have tested positive for COVID-19 (and have been released from isolation) individual must present a printed or digital government-issued documentation of positive COVID-19 test to include ending date of isolation.

Individuals who cannot provide proof of vaccination or a valid COVID-19 test according to the conditions outlined above will not be allowed to enter an indoor event at Carl Sandburg College.
